

Re: Temporary Staff Position for Summer 2009

Temporary summer employment is available for the 2009 session of the Pennsylvania Governor's School for the Sciences (PGSS). This summer we have the following staff position available

- Chemistry Storeroom Attendant (hourly @ \$10/hr, paid bi-weekly)

The Chemistry Storeroom Attendant will work under the direction of the PGSS Chemistry Faculty. Responsibilities include pre-program inventory of glassware and chemicals, distribution of glassware and chemicals during laboratory sessions, and post-program inventory. The storeroom must be kept clean and in order at all times.

The regularly scheduled time is 2:30 – 5:30 P.M. on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays during the first four weeks of the program. Additional time is scheduled, as needed, before the start of the program, during the program and during the fifth week of the program, for inventory, setup and cleanup.

Applicants should have at least two years of college-level chemistry laboratory experience. Current undergraduate chemistry majors or high school chemistry teachers are especially encouraged to apply
